

School Council Meeting Minutes

27/04/17

The minutes from the previous meeting were adopted by the council.

Matters arising from today's meeting;

- Council met some of the Cultural Ambassadors and discussed their role with them. Council felt that it was a good initiative and would like to see it included in our Pastoral Care Policy.
- Councillors agreed that it was important that they wore their school council badges every day as it promoted their presence to other pupils.
- Councillors were happy with the notice boards and agreed to update them regularly.
- The code of Conduct was approved by SMT and Miss Joyce spoke about it at Yr 6 & 7 assembly. Council agreed that it should be displayed in all toilet areas (Ashleigh & Derryvolgie), mounted on wood and secured to the wall. Council felt it would be good if all paper etc. stuck to walls and any other form of vandalism was cleared away to show how important the SMT viewed the matter.
- Councillors will visit Key Stage 1 classes to talk about the toilet area behaviours.
- The council are happy with the buddy Stop initiative but not so confident in the durability of the signs. With this in mind they are going to run a competition for Key Stage 1 pupils to design a sign for the 'Buddy Stop'. The winner will have their design made into weather resistant signs that will be attached to the most convenient area on the wall in all yards. The winner will receive a prize sponsored by the PTA.

- There will be a competition for Key Stage 2 students to design a logo and compose motto for St Bride's School Council. Once again there will be a prize sponsored by the PTA. Winners will be announced at assemblies and their picture will be put on the website, in the magazine and released to the local press.
- Hannah and Lucy will edit a newsletter about School Council business this year and circulate it to all year groups. They hope to have it ready by mid-June.
