November - Christmas 2018

Literacy:

Children will learn to write Reports, Recounts and Narratives. They will use associated language; Who, What, Where, When. First, next, then and finally. The children will sequence and retell stories. In December they will write a letter to Santa and write lists. The children are being introduced to fairy tales and non-fiction books.

Tips for parents:

Ask the children what they observe on their journey to and from school. Identify rhymes and blends. Reinforce the structure of a story when reading to your child, NB: Beginning, Middle and End. Ask plenty of questions about the story and get the children to answer in full sentences not one word answers. Discuss if the book you are reading is a story or a non-fiction book. How do you know the difference? (A non-fiction book usually has photos, it is true and may have a contents, index and glossary.)

Numeracy:

It is essential that the children develop quick recall of addition and subtraction facts within 20. They should recognise and make amounts using 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p & 20p coins. The children should recognise o'clock and half past. They should continue to recognise 2D & 3D shapes.

Tips for parents:

Plenty of oral questioning about the numbers before and after, remind them when using a number line counting forwards and back. Ask them about the price of things when you are out shopping. Reinforce number stories by revising weekly facts.

World Around Us

The children will learn about People who help us. They will be aware of the different jobs that people do and the importance of them in the environment.

Tips for parents:

Talk to the children about People who help us. Encourage them to recognise all the jobs that people do to help them every day. Encourage the children to observe the seasonal changes. During December we will need evergreen branches and bags of rice for Outdoor Play.

ICT

The children have started to go to ICT suite. They are beginning to use some simple programs. Please encourage the children to become familiar with the keyboard.
